#### **NOTICE OF PUBLIC RIGHTS**

Accounts and Audit Regulations 2003, regs. 13, 14 and 16.

NOTICE is given that from 5 July, 2010 to 30 July, 2010 between 9.30 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. (Saturdays and Sundays excepted) any person interested may inspect, and make copies of, the accounts of the Leicestershire County Council, its pension fund and the Eastern Shires Purchasing Organisation for the year ended 31 March, 2010, and the books and deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts relating thereto.

NOTICE is also given that on or after 30 July, 2010 at 10.00 am until the completion of the audit, the Auditor, at the request of a local government elector for any area to which the accounts relate, will give the elector or his or her representative an opportunity to question him about the accounts, and that any such elector or his representative may attend before the auditor and make objections as to any matter in respect of which the Auditor could take action under Sections 17 and 18 of Audit Commission Act 1998 namely, an unlawful item of account, failure to bring a sum into account, or a loss or deficiency caused by wilful misconduct), or could make a report in the public interest under Section 8 of that Act.
