Notice is also given that the 24th August 2009 at 10.00 am is the date on, or after which Local Government Electors for the area to which the accounts relate may exercise their rights under Sections 15 and 16 of the Audit Commission Act 1998 to question the auditors about or make objections to the accounts for the year ended 31st March 2009.
