Each year the Council's accounts are audited and any person interested has the opportunity to inspect and make copies of the accounts and all relevant documents. For the year ending 31st March 2009 these documents will be available on application to the Finance and Customer Services Directorate, Chief Executive's Department, 3rd Floor Riverside House East, Woolwich High Street, Woolwich, London SE18 6BU (telephone 020 8921 5248/6185) between 10.00am and 4.00pm weekdays from Tuesday 16th June 2009 to Monday 13th July 2009.

Local Government Electors for the Greenwich local authority area and their representatives also have the opportunity to question the auditors about the accounts until the audit has been completed. These must be made in writing and sent to the auditor at the address shown below.

Local Government Electors for the Greenwich local authority area and their representatives may also object to the Council's accounts asking that the auditor issue a report in the public interest (under section 8 of the Audit Commission Act 1998) and / or apply to the court for a declaration that an item in the accounts is contrary to law (under section 17 of the Audit Commission Act 1998). Written notice of a proposed objection and the grounds on which it is made must be sent to the auditor at the address shown below and a copy sent to Greenwich Council.

The audit is being carried out by Sue Exton, District Auditor, 1st Floor, Millbank Tower, Millbank, London SW1P 4HQ and will be conducted under the provisions of the Audit Commission Act 1998 and the Accounts and Audit Regulations 2003.
