Notice is given that from 6th July to the 4th August 2009 between 9.30am and 4.30pm, Monday to Friday, any person interested may on application to the Executive Director of Finance, Information Systems and Property, Town Hall, Hornton Street, Kensington, W8 7NX, inspect, and make copies of the accounts of the above-named Council for the year ended 31st March 2009 and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts relating thereto. The accounts and other documents will be available for inspection at Kensington Town Hall, or otherwise by arrangement. Application should be made initially to the Corporate Finance Manager, Town Hall, Hornton Street, Kensington, London W8 7NX.

Notice is also given that on or after 5th August, at the request of a London borough local government elector for any area to which the accounts relate, the auditor will give the elector or his/her representative an opportunity to question him about the accounts. Any such elector or his/her representative may attend before the auditor and make objections as to any matter in respect of which the auditor could take action under Section 17 or 18 of the Audit Commission Act 1998 (namely, an unlawful item of account, failure to bring the sum into account, or loss or deficiency caused by wilful misconduct), or could make a report in the public interest under Section 8 of that Act. No objection may be made unless the auditor, The Audit Commission, 1st Floor, Millbank Tower, Millbank, London SW1P 4HQ has previously received written notice of the proposed objection and its grounds. A copy of that notice must be sent to Mr Nicholas Holgate, Executive Director for Finance, Information Systems and Property, Town Hall, Hornton Street, Kensington, London W8 7NX.
