### **NOTICE OF PUBLIC RIGHTS 2008/2009**

#### **Accounts and Audit Regulations 2003 Regs 13, 14 and 16**

NOTICE is given that from Monday, 13th July 2009 until Friday, 7th August 2009 inclusive, between 9.00 am and 1.00 pm and 2.30 pm and 4.15 pm, any person interested may inspect and make copies of the accounts of the above named Council for the year ended 31 March 2009 and all books, deeds, contracts, bills, vouchers and receipts relating thereto. The accounts and other documents will be available for inspection at the offices at which they are normally kept, or otherwise by arrangement. Application should be made initially to the Head of Financial Services, Borough of Poole, Civic Centre, Poole BH15 2RU.

NOTICE is also given that on or after Monday, 10th August 2009 at 10.00 am until the completion of the audit, the auditor at the request of a local government elector for any area to which the accounts relate, will give the elector or his representative an opportunity to question him about the accounts, and that any such elector or his representative may attend before the auditor and make objections as to any matter in respect of which the auditor could take action under Section 15 and 16 of the Audit Commission Act 1998 (namely, an unlawful item of account, failure to bring a sum into account or a loss or deficiency caused by wilful misconduct), or could make a report in the public interest under Section 8 of that Act.

Questions may be received at the Civic Centre by arrangement with the District Auditor, Simon Garlick Esq, the Audit Commission, Room 161D, Civic Centre, Poole BH15 2RU, to whom requests for this purpose should be addressed. No objection may be made unless the auditor has previously received written notice of the proposed objection and its grounds. A copy of this notice must be sent to the Council at the address below.
